

Call to Worship



In the mercy of almighty God, Christ died for us while we still were sinners; and for his sake, God + forgives you all your sins.



John 3:1-21; 4:1-52




Song of the Day – "I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say" ELW 611





I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.




Apostles' Creed


Do this for the remembrance of me.

Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us.


Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.





As we receive the bread and cup today, we receive grace upon grace from Jesus: forgiveness, new life and salvation.


Come and hold your hands out and receive God's goodness with the holy word of thanks: "Amen!"



Communion Blessing


The body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, which you have now received, strengthen you and keep you in God's grace.



- Needs list in bulletin on July 15th; on table after that




